Doggy Daycare General Information and Policies

The purpose of Something to Wag About, Inc Doggy Daycare Center is to provide a safe, fun and stimulating social environment for dogs during weekday business hours. To ensure the

safety and health of your pet and our other guests, we require all guests to comply with the following rules and regulations:

AGE: All dogs must be at least 12 weeks of age or older

SEX: All dogs 7 months or older must be spayed or neutered

SHOTS: All dogs must have up-to-date vaccinations. Owners must submit written proof of DHLPP and Bordetella vaccinations. Rabies is required for puppies over 4 months of age.

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Owners will certify their dog(s) are in good health and have not been ill with a communicable condition in the last 15 days. Upon admission, all dogs must be free from any condition which could potentially jeopardize other guests. Dogs that have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 15 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be admitted or readmitted.

BEHAVIOR: All dogs must be non-aggressive and not food or toy protective. Owners will certify their dogs have not harmed or shown any aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog(s). Please remember: your pet will be spending time with other pets and the safety and health of all animals is our main concern.

APPLICATION: All dogs must have completed, up-to-date and approved application on file. There is a one-time, \$15.00 non-refundable application screening fee for each pet.

FEES: Fees are based on a pass plan. A pass is valid for 6 months from the date of purchase.

1-day pass: \$28

5-day pass: \$135 (\$27.00 per day) 10-day pass: \$250 (\$25.00 per day) 20-day pass: \$480 (\$24.00 per day)

DAYS AND HOURS: Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The Center is not an overnight facility. Staff goes off duty at 5:00 p.m. and there is a \$1.00 per minute charge for any pet left after 5:00 p.m.

RESERVATIONS: Required. Cancellations with less than 24 hours notice will be charged full fees.

- 1. I understand that I am solely responsible for any harm caused by my dog(s) while my dog(s) is/are attending Something to Wag About, Inc Doggy Daycare Center.
- 2. I further understand and agree that in admitting my dog(s) to the Center, Something to Wag About, Inc Doggy Daycare's staff have relied on my representation that my dog(s) is/are in good health and has/have not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dogs.
- 3. I further understand and agree that Something to Wag About, Inc Doggy Daycare Center and their staff and volunteers, will not be liable for any problems that develop, provided reasonable care and precautions are followed, and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind whatsoever arising from my dog's/dogs' attendance and participation at the Center.
- 4. I further understand and agree that dogs can sometimes receive minor cuts and scratches at doggy daycare and any problems that develop with my dog(s) will be treated as deemed best by staff and volunteers of Something to Wag About, Inc Doggy Daycare Center, at their sole discretion, and that I assume full financial responsibility for any and all expenses involved.

5. I understand that even though Something to Wag About requires that every dog be vaccinated with the Bordetella vaccine, it can spread a bit like the common cold in grade schools. Additionally, I acknowledge that the vaccine does not protect my dog from every new strain of the virus, therefore I will not hold Something to Wag About responsible for any incurred vet bills due to Bordetella or any other respiratory illnesses.

I certify that I have read and understand the policies of the Center as set forth on the preceding pages and that I have read and understand the conditions, and statements of this agreement, including the following:
